FAMILY CAMP FAQs

What time is Check In and Check Out?

Check In is Friday, August 1th between 11am and 12pm.

Check Out is Sunday, August 13th between 1pm and 2pm.

What should I pack?

Plan for hot and cool weather, and pack old, comfortable clothes! Also plan for activities such as pottery, gardening, sports, swimming, and dancing. There is approximately a 10" high space under each bunk to store luggage, so soft duffel bags are better than trunks. This list is a guideline, and you may want to bring more or less of any item.

- 1 pair jeans/pants
- 2 pairs shorts
- 3-4 tank tops/t-shirts
- 5 changes of underwear
- 5 pairs of socks
- 1 pair of closed-toe shoes
- 1 pair of flip-flops or sandals
- 1 poncho or raincoat
- 1 bathing suit
- 2 sweatshirts/sweaters/jackets
- 2-3 pairs of pajamas
- 1 shirt hanger to hang towel
- 1 pillow, 1 set of twin sheets, 1-2 pillow cases, a blanket, 2 towels



**Camp will provide a bedroll if you are traveling by plane

- Shower caddy
- Toiletries, sunscreen, insect repellent, any hair care products that are important to your comfort
- Sunglasses, hat or visor, analog watch
- Books, card games, pens/pencils, notebook
- Flashlight, disposable camera, batteries
- Comfort items- stuffed animals, favorite blankets, family photos, posters

Can I bring in outside food?

Generally, we do not permit outside food in our bunks because it attracts bugs and other critters. We serve three full meals and two snacks each day out of our dining hall, so we encourage families to enjoy the food provided.

We understand that many families live with food allergies and sensitivities, and we strive to make eating away from home as safe as possible. We are not a peanut-free camp, but can accommodate campers with mild nut, dairy, and gluten allergies. Appel Farm is typically able to accommodate vegetarian, vegan, gluten-free, lactose/dairy-free, pork-free, and peanut-free diets. We recommend that kosher campers and campers who do not eat beef, turkey, or chicken, register themselves as vegetarian while at camp. Please be sure to let us know if you are diabetic, or have an allergy or medical contraindication to certain foods or drinks not otherwise addressed here. When very complex dietary needs require additional support, we will work with families individually.

Are activities for families to do together, or can adults and kids separate for different activities?

Family Camp offers both! Throughout the day, participants will have their choice of activities. Some will be designed for people of all ages, and some geared to those of a certain age range. Throughout the day, the Little Appels Kids Club will be open for our youngest campers to have fun exploring while other family members take time out to rest and rejuvenate, or participate in an artmaking activity of their own.



Is this tent camping or are we sleeping indoors?

Family Camp offers air conditioned bunk housing for our families. Our bunks can sleep up to 10 comfortably. Bunks contain bunk beds, and each bunk has one private bathroom with a shower.

What if I need to refrigerate or store medication?

Our Health Center has a locked refrigerator where medication may be safely stored. Our health center staff is on call 24-7 and will happily work with you to accommodate your family's needs.

Am I permitted to bring alcohol?

People over the age of 21 are welcome to bring adult beverages with them to Family Camp. Please be aware that there is no refrigeration available in the bunks. All adult beverages must be kept out of the reach of minors, and must be disposed of in one of the camp trash or recycling bins within 24 hours of consumption to keep our sleeping premises free from pests. Adults consuming alcohol are expected to maintain a level of behavior appropriate for Family Camp. Inappropriate or dangerous behavior resulting from the consumption of alcohol will be cause for immediate removal from the premises without refund. Distribution of alcohol to minors is strictly prohibited.

What activities are restricted?

Appel Farm is a smoke free campus. Non-prescription drugs are strictly prohibited. Violation of these policies is grounds for immediate removal from the premises without refund.

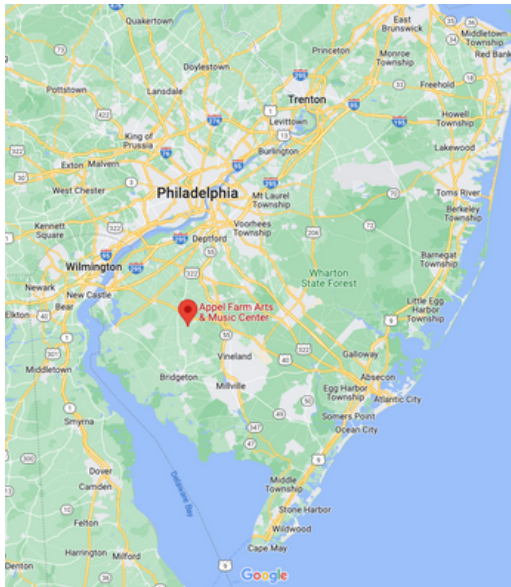
