



HONORING ALBERT & CLARE APPEL

In the **late 1950s** with the purchase of the current land, Clare and Albert initially became farmers with the entire family tending over 20,000 chickens. Attending elementary school and processing eggs after school, the Appel children also practiced lessons in classical music. Each of the Appel children, Judy, Toby, Aliza and Julius have many memories of the center's origins from sixty-five years ago.

In **1960**, guided by a sense of curiosity and grounded in humor and hard work, <u>Clare and Albert Appel</u> transitioned their 176-acre farm and its multitude of chickens into a thriving summer community focused on the raw talent and emergent curiosity of humans aged 7 to 17: <u>Appel Farm Arts Camp</u> was born. Starting as a day camp, across the street at the main house, camp included baking in the kitchen with Clare, putting on theatre productions in the corncrib, and creating beautiful music in the "New House" studio designed by renowned architect Frank Weise.

This amazing story is being documented through a partnership between Appel Farm Arts & Music Center, Sara and Sam Schoffer Holocaust Resource Center at Stockton University, and the New Jersey Commission on Holocaust Education. Working with Aliza Appel (Clare and Albert Appel's daughter), the group is documenting photographs and stories of the Jewish chicken farmers in the area, including her family, for the Holocaust Survivors of South Jersey Project.
